CONTENT Vocabulary and content are appropriate to a middle/high school audience. Challenging concepts are explained or otherwise illuminated.					
ACTION / PACING The performance is exciting. Movements are effectively planned and well placed to add to the action. Individual actors' performances feel well-rehearsed; little-to-no down time between scenes.					
VOICE / DIALOGUE There is an appropriate amount of dialogue. Voices are loud and clear; dialogue is easily understood and characters are distinguishable.
